Very chalky with aromas of flint and stone fruit. On the palate creaminess with persistent length.</p> <p>"Katharina's 2019 Westhofen Riesling Trocken displays a golden-yellow color and opens with an intense yet refined and elegant bouquet of ripe fruits intertwined with flinty/chalky notes that give a coolish attitude. Mouthfilling, intense and aromatic on the palate, this is a fresh and pure Riesling that is not as rich and juicy-textured as expected from the nose. There are citric notes and green apple flavors on the aftertaste. 13% alcohol."
