<b>TASTING</b>	<p>This Pinot Noir impresses with its fine and light structure. Through the short mash contact and storage in multiple used barriques this benefits from a light tannin structure. In the nose, the use of barrique plays only a minor role - pure Pinot Noir fruit is in the foreground dominated by sweet and sour cherry flavors.
